Terms and conditions of your offer

1. Unless otherwise specified, these terms and conditions apply to individuals applying to study at the University of Suolk, or studying on a University of Suolk validated degree at a University of Suolk Partner College or an academic partner of the University of Suolk where the offer is made for current or previous study. It is your responsibility to provide full and accurate

information and to notify University of Suolk of any changes or corrections. The information provided in your application will form part of your student record after you have enrolled.

3. A contractual relationship between you and the University of Suolk will be formed upon your acceptance of an offer to study.
4. The University of Suolk will communicate with you by email, letter, phone or text based on the contact information you provide on your application. You must regularly check all forms of communication as detailed by you on your application and inform the University of Suolk if there are any changes to this information. It is your responsibility to comply with deadlines/

11. As part of your application, you will be required to declare any relevant criminal convictions as defined by the University of Suolk Admissions Policy . If a criminal conviction is not declared and subsequently becomes known, this will be treated in accordance with the University of Suolk Admissions Policy or the University of Suolk Safeguarding Policy and could result in withdrawal of an offer or from the course.
12. If you accept our offer of a place you are confirming that you agree to fulfil the attendance requirements of the programme.
13. Any offer of a place on course which leads to professional status is for a programme of study only and does not guarantee eventual registration to practice or registration with the relevant professional body.
14. The University of Suolk is a Highly Trusted Sponsor, and issues Confirmation of Acceptance of Studies (CAS) in accordance with the University of Suolk Admissions Policy .
15. The University of Suolk may withdraw or suspend a course in the circumstances set out in the University of Suolk Admissions Policy. Students accepted will be contacted as early as possible and will be given the right to withdraw their acceptance of the offer and receive a refund. More information about the reasons for the withdrawal or suspension of a course, and how applicants will be supported, is available in the University of Suolk Admissions Policy .
16. You agree, as a condition of accepting the offer and enrolling at the University of Suolk, to be aware of, and comply with, the University of Suolk's policies, rules, regulations and procedures ('the Regulations'), as amended and approved from time to time. The relevant Policies include the University of Suolk Admissions Policy, the University of Suolk General Regulations, the Data Protection Policy and the University of Suolk Tuition Fees Policy. Applicants should note that information about Intellectual Property is contained within the University of Suolk General Regulations.
17. The University of Suolk has a duty to enrol any applicant who has accepted an offer and fulfilled relevant entry conditions
18. Delivery of the chosen programme of study is in accordance with the description provided, and provision of relevant facilities and assessments/ award in accordance with University of Suolk Policies . Any changes to courses required during the course of study, will be made in consultation with current students and the Students' Union.
19. Unless otherwise agreed in writing between the parties, this Agreement shall be subject to and construed and interpreted in accordance with English Law and shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts of England.
